I. RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

A. Eligibility

- 1. Applicant must be enrolled as an undergraduate student at a university or community college at the time of application, and funds must be applied to undergraduate studies for either the fall 2018 or spring 2019 semester.
- 2. Applicant must pursue a degree relating to a career in Construction.
- 3. Applicant must have successfully completed a minimum of 40 semester college credit hours if pursuing a bachelor's degree.
- 4. Applicants must have successfully completed a minimum of 25 semester college credit hours if pursuing an associate's degree.
- 5. Applicants must have either a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher or minimum GPA of 3.0 in current major.

B. Requirements

1. The applicant is responsible for ensuring that all of the following items are received by the ABC Greater Houston Chapter Scholarship Committee no later than March 30, 2018 (EXTENDED DEADLINE).

Failure to send ALL of the following information will result in automatic disqualification.

- Completed original application form.
- Two reference letters to be completed on letterhead and/or signed by the person of reference (these can be scanned, emailed, faxed, or mailed directly by the reference).
- Unofficial transcript or grade report from the college registrar.
- Copy of degree plan.
- A typed, doubled spaced, two pages or less essay.

C. Awards

- 1. The ABC Greater Houston Chapter Scholarship Committee will determine the number of and dollar amount of each awarded scholarship at their discretion. The Committee will award scholarships up to the combined amount of \$20,000.
- The ABC Greater Houston Chapter Scholarship Committee will review applications in April 2018. The
 committee will take into consideration each applicant's interest in construction, grades, extracurricular
 activities, employment experience, and financial need if given.
- 3. Scholarship funds will be sent to each recipient's college or university for disbursement. Some restrictions may apply to the disbursement and use of the funds.
- 4. All scholarship recipients will be announced no later than April 9, 2018. Awards will be available for the 2018-2019 school year.
