



Benefits of Industry Sponsorship for High Schools using the NCCER Curriculum

Sponsoring a high school can be different for each company. The following list provides examples of how owners and contractors are sponsoring high schools. The list is not all inclusive and companies provide various levels of support as a sponsor.

- Speak to the students and faculty about the benefits of using an industry-recognized competency-based, standardized quality curriculum.
- Provide interview opportunities for students who are registered in the NCCER data base and have an industry-recognized credential.
- Provide financial assistance for the purchase of NCCER Instructor and Trainee books, hand/power tools, and/or laboratory supplies.
- Donate scholarship funds for designated craft training at CMEF or a local community college.
- Donate PPE, hand/power tools, and/or laboratory supplies relative to the crafts taught.
- Provide industry guest speakers.
- Provide industry speakers at Career Fairs.
- Serve on Advisory Committees.
- Provide “How To” demonstrations at the high school or at a job site.
- Provide field trip opportunities.

- Provide co-operative education or internship opportunities.

- Facilitate an annual safety audit of the laboratory.

- Facilitate safety training for students and faculty.

- Potential priority in job placement over applicants with no NCCER curriculum training.
